Details: Ju-Juanna Latif is a single, working mother of four children, including a nine-year-old son with cerebral palsy. She has made her way through the welfare system and has succeeded in buying a home for her family, but the home is falling apart and is not accessible for her wheelchair-bound son. Not only is Latif’s home falling apart, but so is the home of next-door neighbor and adopted grandma Rose Chatman. Chatman has been an instrumental part of Latif’s family and has helped care for the children so Latif can continue to work as a welfare fraud analyst.
